



OWNER'S MANUAL

Thank you for choosing JETXTENDER. Before using your new product, please take a minute to read the following warning and safety information. This manual is intended to alert you to potential hazards that may occur in all water sports.

THIS MANUAL CONTAINS IMPORTANT PRODUCT AND SAFETY INFORMATION

This manual is available in the following languages DE, EN, IT, FR, ES. Dealers of other countries are obliged to translate the manual into the respective national language and make it available to their clients.

WARNING

Use of this product and participation in the sport involves inherent risks of injury or death. To reduce risks:

- Always read User's Manual before use.
- The faster you ride the greater the risk of injury.
- The maximum speed for the JETXTENDER is 37km/h-20kn (23mph).
- Up to a maximum of 6 passengers are allowed on the JETXTENDER only in the bow in front of the jet ski. Persons are only allowed to sit on or in front of the sitting roll. All passengers must hold on to avoid falling forward, backward or outside. For the passenger's safety in the JETXTENDER, the speed has always to be adjusted according to the wave and wind conditions.
- Sitting next to the jet ski or bringing your hands, legs or head between the Jet Ski and JETXTENDER is absolutely forbidden and life-threatening!
- Use only with a qualified Jet Ski driver.
- The driver should always choose adequate speed to provide control and stability.
- All passengers on the JETXTENDER and the Jet Ski must wear a well-fitting lifejacket, certified to EN ISO 12402-5, or a similarly approved vest.
- Ensure the correct installation of the JETXTENDER. Check the belts and air pressure before starting and while driving.
- Do not ride in shallow water or close to shoreline, docks, piles, swimming people, floating products or any other boats and obstacles.
- Do not tow or ride under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- The CE certification is valid within European Union and countries which recognize the laws of the EU: Australia, Qatar, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey. In all other countries the user must inform himself about local laws.
- Read and understand the owner's manual before use.
- Use at your own risk

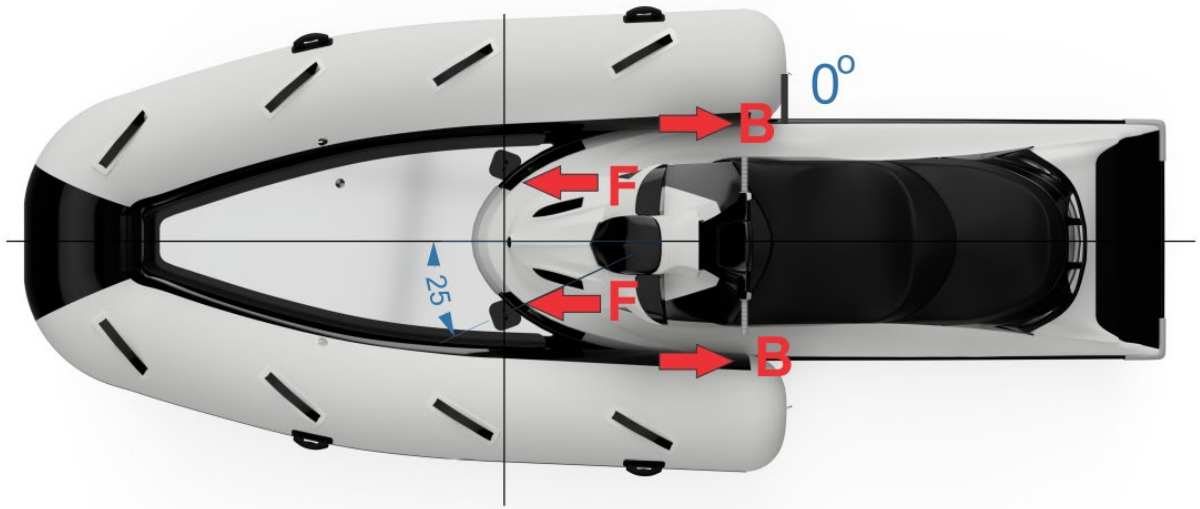
To reduce risk of injury or death please follow these rules

Equipment & Safety:

- The sitting roll has to be fixed before riding.
- Before each use check carefully the Jet Ski, JETXTENDER and also the connections for loose screws, cracks, chafing or damage. Before driving and during the trip, check the straps for damage, because breakage while driving could lead to an uncontrollable exit. This could cause injury or even death. Therefore straps with traces of use should be changed immediately. Also check ropes, vests and accessories. Equipment with signs of wear could cause injury and should be replaced immediately.
- Always make sure that the straps are securely fastened, checked and re-tensioned if necessary when in use.
- Air pressure: Working pressure is 200 mbar / 3 psi for keel, side tubes and seat roll and 400 mbar / 6 psi for the flat bottom part of the JETXTENDER.
- Check the air pressure of the JETXTENDER before each ride.
- Only a qualified, experienced and responsible driver, who follows all rules and regulations, is allowed to steer the jet ski with the JETXTENDER.
- Observe the applicable federal and state laws. Be aware of local hazards and inherent risks.
- The driver and all passengers always have to wear a well-fitting lifejacket certified to EN ISO 12402-5 or a similarly approved vest.
- Jet Ski drivers and JETXTENDER passengers must be able to communicate by standard hand signals. For minimum: "It's all ok" and "Stop".
- JETXTENDER passengers should be aware that falling into water could result in serious injury or death. Persons are only allowed to sit on or in front of the sitting roll. All passengers must hold on to avoid falling forward, backward or outside. For the passenger's safety in the JETXTENDER, the speed has always to be adjusted according to the wave and wind conditions.
- The Jet Ski driver is responsible for a safety ride and the proper use of the device.
- Never ride under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- After using remove dirt, sand and saltwater. Do not use aggressive or abrasive cleaners.

JETXTENDER MONTAGE

Mounting eyelets on the jet ski: Only a professional may fitted them at the correct angle. See sketch



Unpack the JETXTENDER on clear surface. Inflate with electric or hand pump. Start with bottom then and tubes.

Max. pressure is 200 mbar (3 psi) for tubes and sitting role and 400 mbar (6 psi) for flat bottom part.



Mount the bolts to the holes which are meant for screws on your Jet Ski. At the model Seadoo Spark the screws for position **F** and **B** have to be 6mm eyebolts.

First connect back bolts with webbing.



Push the jet-ski as much as you can to the front and up, tie front webbings.



Inflate front tube-fence and secure it with the webbing on the bottom or on the side according to the preparations on the main hull.



Respect safety regulations in your country.

Do not exceed 20 knots max. speed when you use your JETXTENDER!
